

DUE TO CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE ALPURRURULAM COMMUNITY CUTTING FENCES, LEAVING RUBBISH AT WATER HOLES AND BRINGING ALCOHOL THROUGH "LAKE NASH CATTLE STATION" PADDOCKS INTO THE COMMUNITY.

## AS OF TODAY 24<sup>TH</sup> OF NOVEMBER 2010 "LAKE NASH" CATTLE STATION IS OUT OF BOUNDS TO ALL ALPURRURULAM COMMUNITY MEMBERS

THIS HAS HAPPENED BECAUSE SOMEONE IN YOUR COMMUNITY HAS CUT THE FENCE NEAR THE POWER STATION AND HAS BOUGHT ALCOHOL INTO THE COMMUNITY THROUGH THE CATTLE STATION.

UNTIL THE FENCES ARE FIXED AND PEOPLE STOP BRING ALCOHOL INTO THE COMMUNITY, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SWIM, FISH OR GO CAMPING ON THE CATTLE STATION ANYWHERE. PEOPLE THAT DISOBEY THIS WILL BE TRESSPASSED FROM THE CATTLE STATION FOR 1 YEAR.
